2. Ensure the tradesman can start and complete the works in your requested time frame. Use our [FREE CONTRACT DOWNLOAD](#) to set out times and dates to adhere to and both parties in agreement.
3. Make sure all quotes are detailed and have enough information and include ALL COSTS involved.
4. Ask if they provide any guarantees with their work. This gives peace of mind if something was to go wrong.
5. Be wary of quotes that are much lower than others. This could indicate compromise on quality.
6. Never pay in full upfront.
7. Outline clearly what work is required so there is no confusion for both parties. This will give you and the tradesman clarity on the works carried out and the cost involved.
